Worship Planning Notes

Stewardship of that which God has given so that we can leave a Godly inheritance for our children is the focus of Revival I. Worshippers should be encouraged to take personal responsibility through sound financial planning and spending, and by being examples of Christians who are faithful to the Word of God, so that we exemplify for our children how to be better stewards of all with which God entrusts them. Suggestions for Worship to Make Today's Focus Come Alive

- Select a couple of persons in the congregation and have them give brief presentations on the theme **“Leaving a Godly Inheritance for our Children.”**
- Have a photographer or persons within your church who are able to create digital web images to provide pictures that bring the theme to life. Place the pictures throughout the church during revival season. Images could include parents presenting Bibles to children, parents praying with children, parents giving children a piggy bank and a savings passbook to teach them financial literacy, etc.
